


# Brewed for You Magic Card



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- **Stamp Sets** – Brewed for You (159087)
- **Card Stock** – Sahara Sand (121043); Early Espresso (119686); Basic White (159276)
- **Stamp Pads** – Memento (132708); Crushed Curry (147087); Sahara Sand (147117); Stazon (101406)
- **Misc.** – He's the Man Designer Paper (159068); Window Sheets (142314); Rustic Metallic Adhesive-Backed Dots (159082); Stylish Shapes Dies (159183); Daffodil Delight Stampin' Blends (154883); Wink of Stella (141897); Foam Adhesive Strips (141825); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653)



## Measurements:

Sahara Sand – 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" – score at 4 1/4"  
 Early Espresso – 4" x 10 1/2" – score at 5 1/4";  
 3 1/4" x 3 1/4"; 1 1/2" x 4"; 1/2" x 3 1/4"; 1 1/4" x 3"  
 Basic White – 3 1/2" x 4 3/4"; 2 7/8" x 4 3/4"; 1" x 3 1/4"  
 He's the Man DSP – 3 3/4" x 5"  
 Window Sheet – 3 1/2" x 4 3/4"

1. Fold Sahara Sand on score line
2. Cut Early Espresso on score line from 1/2" to 3 1/2" to create slit for the slider
3. Adhere DSP to Early Espresso
4. Using second largest square from Stylish Shapes Dies to cut a hole in the Early Espresso/DSP card front
5. Using largest and second largest squares from Stylish Shapes Dies cut 3 1/4" Early Espresso to create frame for card front – adhere frame around card front hole

6. Lay 3 1/2" x 4 3/4" Basic White inside Early Espresso and stamp beer mug and foam with **Memento ink**
7. Lay Window Sheet over stamp image lining up edges – stamp beer mug with **Stazon** ink, lining up with beer mug on Basic White
8. Stamp beer with Crushed Curry ink on Basic White stamped image. Color in the rest of the glass with Dark Daffodil Delight Stampin' Blend
9. Color Wink of Stella on foam on glass
10. Adhere Basic White stamped piece to inside of Early Espresso centering mug in hole
11. Lay Window Sheet over Basic White lining up mug
12. Put adhesive around open and close over window sheet
13. Attach Foam Adhesive Strips along edges of sides and bottom of Early Espresso
14. Die cut 1 1/4" x 3" Early Espresso with widest short banner from Stylish Shapes Dies – cut banner in half
15. Attach to top of 2 7/8" Basic White to create pull tab
16. Adhere 1/2" x 3 1/4" Early Espresso to bottom of 2 7/8" Basic White – this creates a stopper so the piece doesn't pull out when you create the magic
17. Slip the Basic White with pull tab into center of card through the slit – this covers the colored mug so all you see is an empty mug
18. Pull backings off Foam Adhesive Strips and close card to seal
19. Adhere Early Espresso card to Sahara Sand card base
20. Die cut 1 1/2" x 4" Early Espresso with largest banner from Stylish Shapes Dies
21. Die cut 1" x 3 1/4" Basic White with thinner long banner – stamp greeting with Memento ink
22. Adhere greeting to Early Espresso, then attach to card front with Dimensionals
23. Add Rustic Metallic Adhesive-Backed Dots
